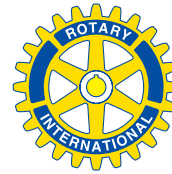
One day a man was walking along the beach when he noticed a boy picking up a starfish and gently throwing it into the ocean.

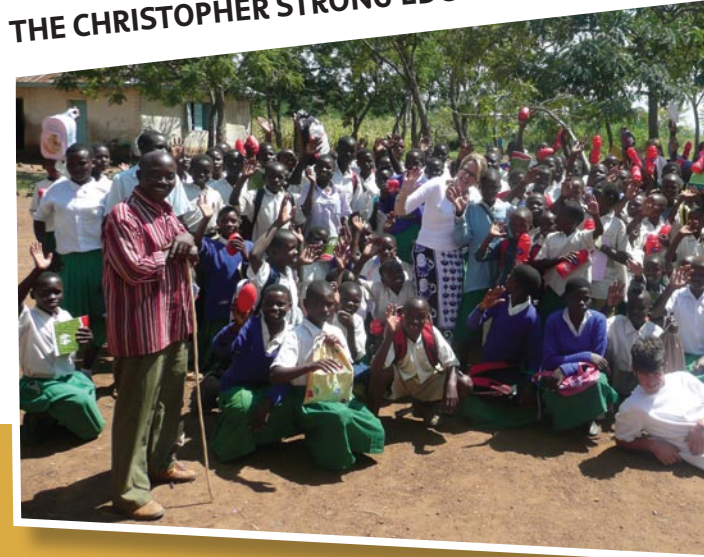

Making a Difference— Teaching the Teachers

In Tarime only 74% of children attend primary school and a mere 24% will go on to attend high school.

Families in Tarime value education highly, but schools are poorly resourced and few current teachers are formally trained.

We aim to make a difference by providing a scholarship to train teachers for service in the Tarime district of Tanzania.

Local villagers will be given the opportunity to receive teacher training and to teach within the district.

Teacher training, along with better teacher resources being provided by The Peter Hewitt Care for Africa Foundation, will make a difference to the opportunities of these people.

Your tax deductible donation will be added to a capital fund to provide a sustainable scholarship to train Tarime's teachers. The current cost of training a teacher is \$1,000 over 2 years.
